13-Year-old Prep League

The league has been structured to ensure that each youngster has the opportunity to play at a level commensurate with his ability. Therefore, the league has made an arrangement for the **13 year olds to play in a Prep League** against teams from surrounding areas. This program has been a tremendous success, as it has allowed each to make the transition to the much larger field while continuing to have the chance to play skilled positions against players of the same physical size and age.

The Babe Ruth Major League will be comprised of 14 and 15 year olds teams will be formed to play against each other and other area teams. We anticipate that all games will be played on weekends.

The 16, 17 and 18 year-old division who will play ONLY on Sunday (1) 9-inning game (Home games will be Sunday Night at West Harrison Park) against each other and other area teams.

Harrison High School Baseball Coaches encourage all players to participate in Babe Ruth Spring Leagues. The league will strive to avoid conflicts with High School Baseball commitments. All players who want to participate in Summer League play MUST participate and play in more than 50% of league games in the Babe Ruth Program.
